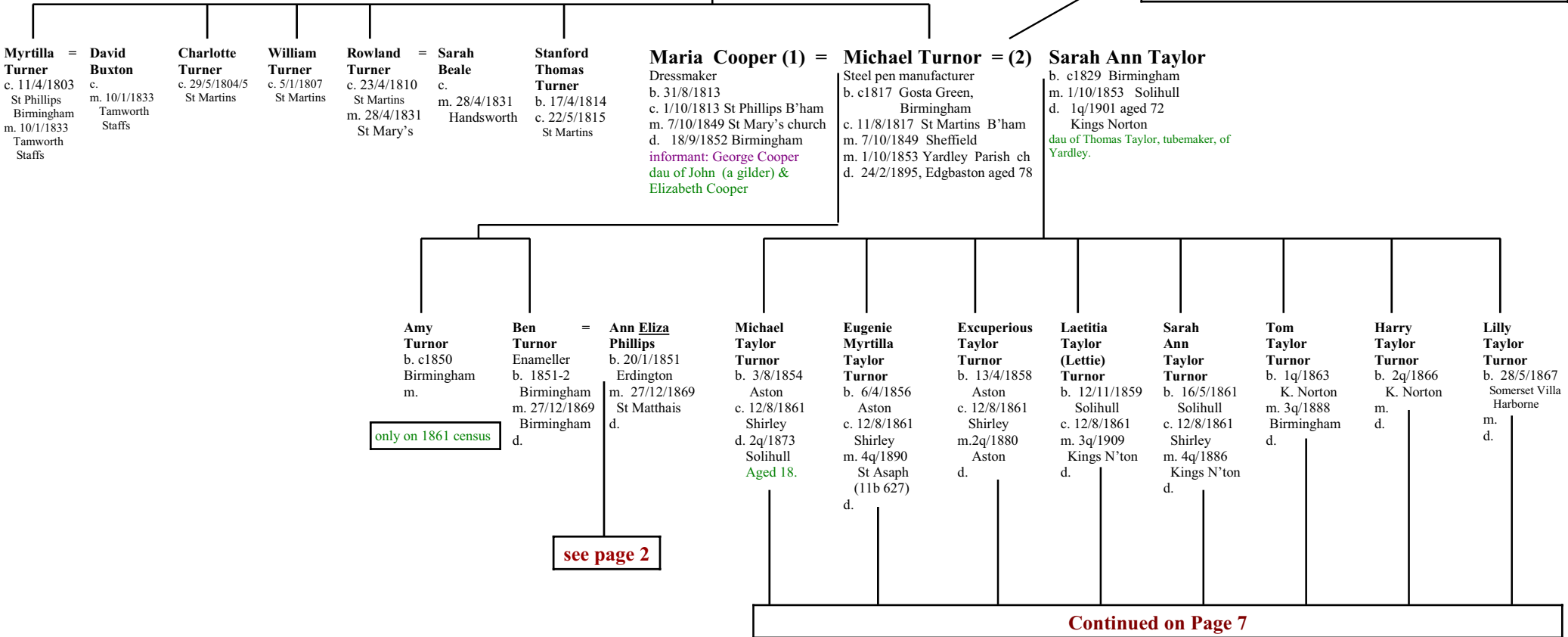


Michael Turnor's company, Michael Turnor & Co, Steel Pen Manufacturers, were at the following:

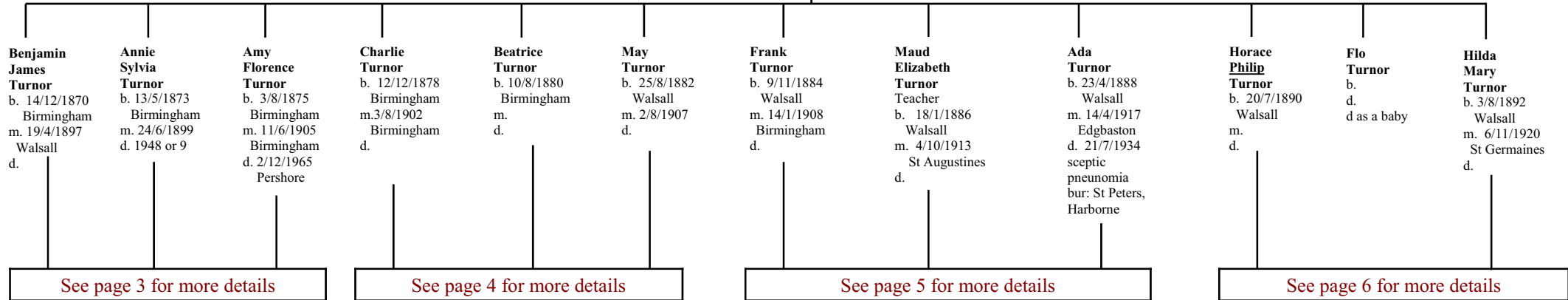

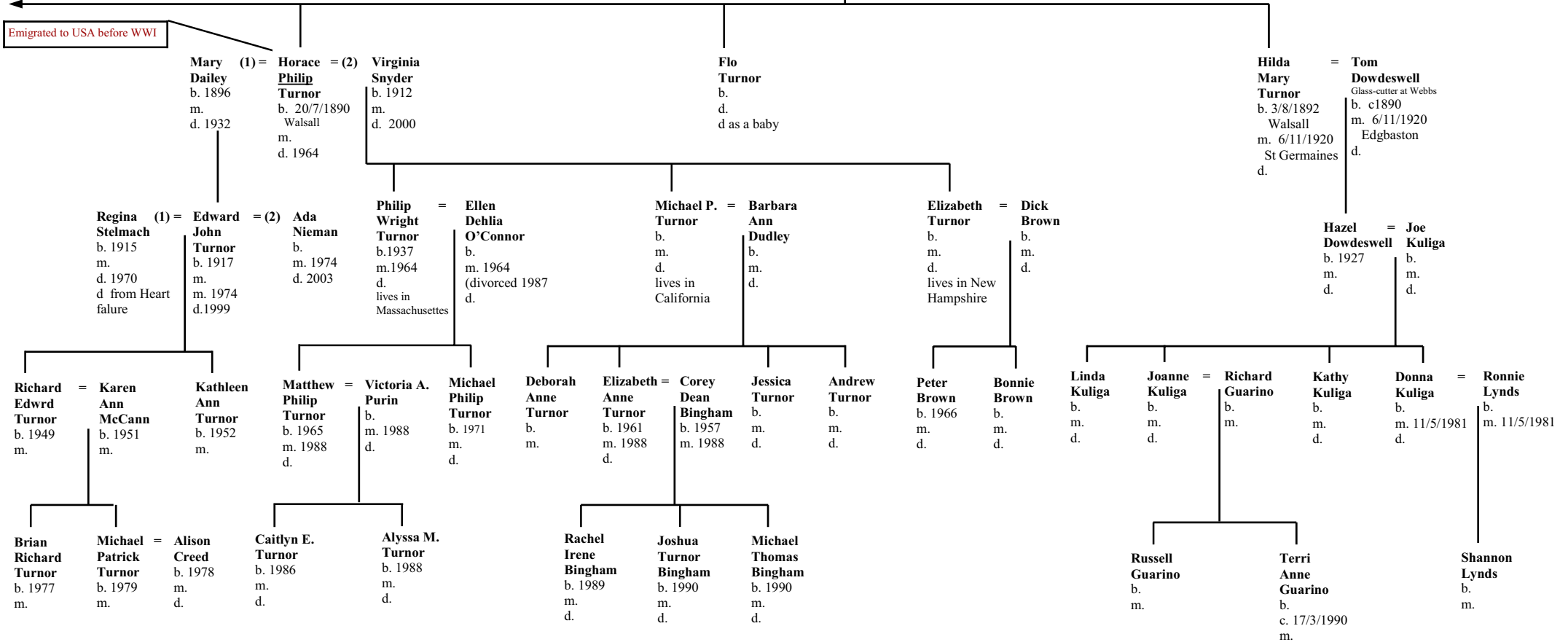
